up to 175cc
hardtail or swing arm
Class C tires

Mad Dog 100

100-150cc 4 strokes
pit bikes OK
no knobbies

Early 250cc

pre- 1967 250cc
no brakes, foot shift
aftermarket frames OK
Class C tires

Junkyard 250's

novice and senior only
Air-cooled, four stroke and two strokes
Up to 250cc
staggered start, faster riders to the rear, up to 3/4 lap
no knobbies

Early 500 to 750

pre- 1967 500cc overhead valves to 750cc side valves
no brakes, foot shift, hand clutch
Class C tires

Vintage 250/499cc

brakes required
air cooled
single or twin engines
Class C tires

Flat Track Classes (continued)

Vintage Open

up to 1980 model year
rear brake required
Twin shocks
water cooled allowed- no antifreeze allowed

Hand shift/ foot clutch

no brakes
rigid frame only
hand shift/foot clutch

Outlaw

Pre-1975
Anything can run- choppers, street bikes
Must cover headlamps/tail lamps with tape in case of breakage
all external doo-dads must be removed- no hanging braided clutch covers, bed rolls, etc.

Senior Open

55 +
any class bike except Outlaw

Speedway

No brakes
no transmission or single speeds only
methanol OK.

Light Pro- \$35.00 entry

modern bikes up to 250cc
entry pay-back for 1st-3rd

Open Pro- \$35.00 entry

modern bikes 251-up
entry pay-back 1st-3rd

Race Rules and Rider Requirements:

- All riders **MUST** be 18 years of age or older to compete.
- All riders **MUST** complete the competitor release.
- **NO ALCOHOL** permitted in the pits. Anyone under the influence will not be allowed to compete and will not get a refund.
- All bikes, except Outlaw must be in dirt track trim.
- All machines are subject to tech/safety inspection, and must have the following: working kill button, folding foot pegs (Outlaw excepted), ball end levers, and must be clear of any fuel or oil leaks.
- **NO KNOBBY TIRES**, class C where noted
- Any bike that has made contact with the ground, venue structure or another rider is required to be visually inspected before further competition.
- Rider Apparel:
 - Riders must use a full-face or full coverage helmet.
 - Goggles and face shields required and must be shatterproof
 - Pants and jackets made of leather or other durable materials are required to be worn.
 - Gloves strongly recommended.
 - Boots at least 8" high required.
 - Steel slide shoe recommended.

\$15.00 gate fee gets you into the races, the antique bike show, and the swap meet.

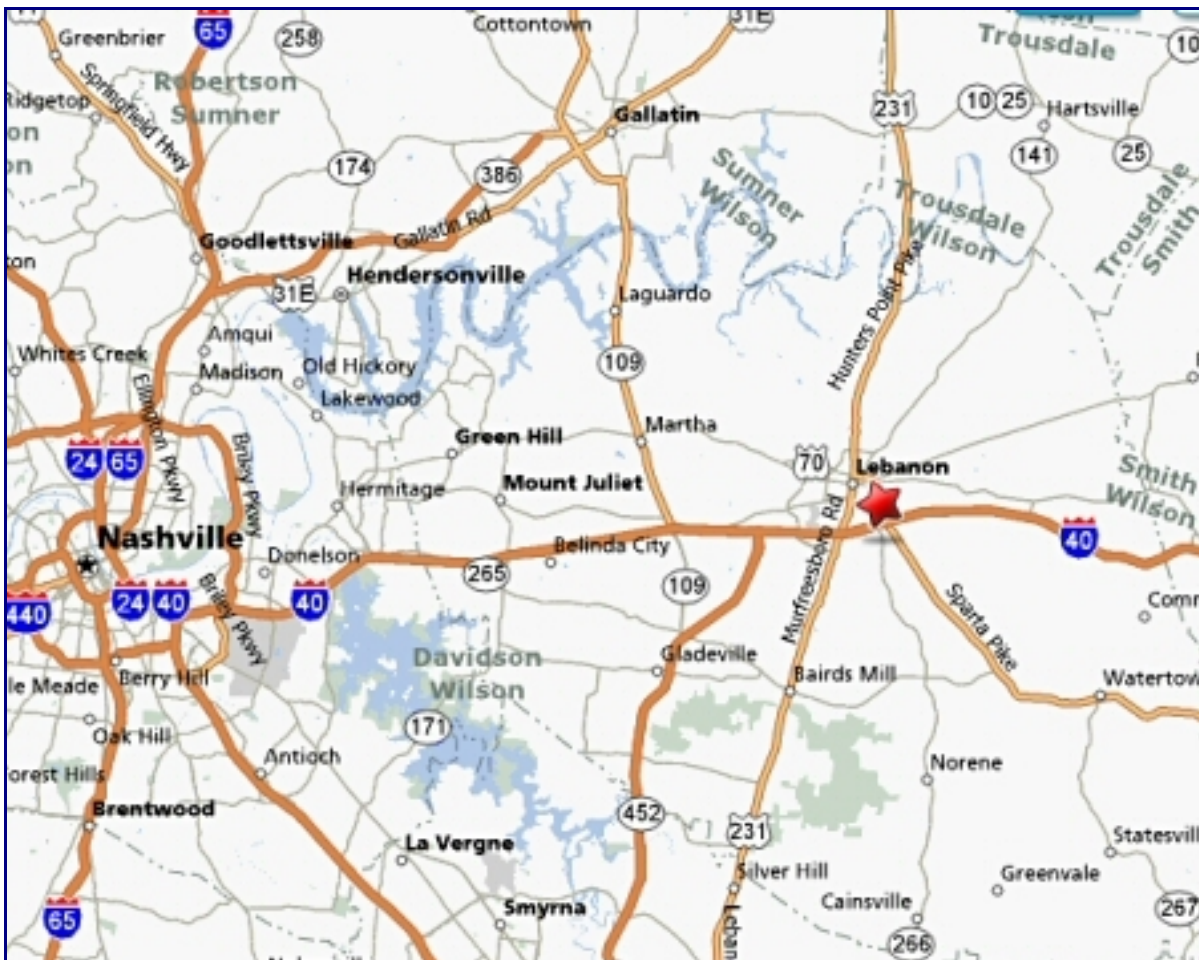
